PROCEDURES FOR ENTRY TO MALDIVES

NO MORE PCR TEST REQUIRED

Since March 29, 2022 no more PCR or Antigen test is required for either vaccinated or non-vaccinated visitors.



All visitors via airport and seaports are still required to complete the Traveller declaration form on the Imuga official website, within 96 hours prior to your flight arrival time.

However, and despite Maldives new protocols, Explorer Ventures strongly encourages all guests to get tested before departing their home country.



TRAVELLER DECLARATION FORM

The Health Declaration Form (HDF) must be filled in and submitted twice by all visitors, 96 hours before your flight arrival time in the Maldives. You may submit the form electronically via https://imuga.immigration.gov.mv/traveller

MANDATORY MASK USE




Face mask use is no more mandatory in the Maldives. Hand sanitizer may not be available everywhere while on land, so please bring your own.
