PROCEDURES FOR ENTRY TO TURKS & CAICOS ISLANDS

NO MORE COVID-19 VACCINATION OR TEST REQUIRED

Effective April 1, 2023, all visitors are not required to be fully vaccinated or to provide a negative PCR test to enter Turks & Caicos Islands anymore.

Pre-travel authorization via TCI Assured and Travel Insurance are no longer required as of May 1, 2022.

As of June 1st, 2023, Explorer Ventures has made the decision to discontinue our requirement for all guests coming aboard the *Turks & Caicos Explorer II* to present negative COVID-19 test results prior to boarding the vessel, regardless of vaccination status. For the safety of all guests and crew, we still encourage you to test prior to leaving home. If any guest becomes symptomatic during a charter, testing, isolation and/or disembarkation may be necessary at your own expense.



INSURANCE & TCI ASSURED ONLINE CERTIFICATION

Pre-travel authorization via TCI Assured and Travel insurance are no longer required as of May 1,

MANDATORY MASK USE

Face mask use is not mandatory anymore in all public areas, restaurants and shops, both indoors and outdoors.





OPTIONAL LAND TOURS

You can visit any place, on any island in the country.

TEMPERATURE CHECK

You may have your temperature checked upon your arrival at Providenciales Airport. Temperature checks might be done while onboard.
